

## **Aldersgate Church Conference Zoom Meeting October 20, 2020**

The meeting opened with a welcome and prayer from District Superintendent Rev. Jeff Mickle at 7:03 p.m.

The evening followed the attached agenda.

After a time of conferencing, Rev. Mickle presented the compensation forms for each pastor. The Salary, Account Reimbursement, Housing Allowance, and Parsonage Exclusion amounts were highlighted and after a bit of explanation, Rev. Mickle called for the vote and the compensation package for each pastor passed unanimously.

Rev. Mickle asked Rev. Orndorff, as chair of the Nominating Team, to present the updates to the Leadership Team. The changes include replacement of Molly Johnson, who is now the Director of Youth and College Ministry, with Mark Husband, and removal of Lew Ashley from the Endowment Team due to his death. Rev. Mickle called for the vote and it passed unanimously. An updated list of Leadership Team Members is included below.

Aldersgate Church has two Certified Lay Servants Lee Anne Orndorff and Molly Johnson. Rev. Mickle called for a vote to continue both individuals and the motion passed unanimously.

Aldersgate Church has one candidate continuing as a Candidate for Ordination. Rev. Mickle called for a vote to continue Alyssa Densham in the process. The motion passed unanimously.

As Aldersgate Church is within Fairfax County, the following motion was brought forward by Paul Amos, and seconded by Marg Soroos:

The lead pastor, Rev. J. Randall Orndorff, of this unincorporated United Methodist congregation in Fairfax County Virginia shall be the person authorized to sign the petition and order for appointment or substitution of church trustees.

The vote was called and the motion passed unanimously.

The Lay Leaders of both congregations, Paul Amos and Shaun Evans, gave reports on the state of each congregation. This was followed by the reports from each of the pastors.

The District Lay Leader and Associate Lay Leader updated those attending on events and information happening throughout the District.

Rev. Mickle closed the meeting at 9:00 p.m. and thanked everyone for coming.
