- Welcome and Opening Prayer Paul Amos
 Paul welcomed everyone and opened the meeting in prayer.

- III. Work of the Church Ministries
 - Strategic Plan Update Debbie Farson
 That is that Connect team has finalized their MAP and will present it to the team
 at this meeting, Engage Team has met once and is on their way to getting their
 MAP done, and I will be in touch with Equip to get going on theirs.
 - Engage Patricia Barron provided an update on the activities of the Engagement Team. Work has begun on creating the child map as part of the strategic planning initiative. She also discussed upcoming events primarily in the Fresh Expressions area
 - Connect <u>Connections & Fellowship</u> John Driscoll & Christine McElwain Presented latest version of Connection Team child MAP. Reported that 600 attended the three Easter services with an additional 200 attending Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services. Reader, usher and communion server volunteers did an excellent job and made an important contribution to the services. Going forward, the Realm databases need to be tweaked so that the Worship lead can manage them. SignUp Genius needs to be adjusted to eliminate months that have already passed. Four ushers per service should be added to accommodate increased in person attendance. Six communion servers per month should also be added.

- Many of the groups that are a part of the Equip/Small Group Ministries completed the Churchwide Study "The Lord's Prayer" in conjunction with the sermon series. Participation of congregants who were not already part of a small group was again low for this study. This will continue to be an area of focus in the future. The Christian Meditation class did add 3 new members for the study. These members came through personal invitation of one of the members of the group, which is a reminder of how important the personal touch is in this area! Pastor Jon noted that Woodlawn UMC has invited members of Aldersgate to participate in a Zoom small group Bible Study on Tuesday mornings or Wednesday evenings. The study is entitled "Urban Apologetics" and more information will be in the newsletter. The Equip ministries leaders have been working on their Child MAP and plan to complete it soon.
