Position Summary: Plan, develop, implement, and expand Children's Ministries. Provides leadership in the area of Christian education for children. The position is part-time, 25-30 hours.

Responsibilities:

- Plan, coordinate and manage the following programs:
 - Children's Sunday school
 - Including a Children's Church, Children's Message, or other activity for days when Sunday School is not offered.
 - Children's Events (e.g. Crafty Kids, Pre-K Valentines, Seasonal events, etc.)
 - Summer Children's Activities (e.g. Summer Sunday School, Children's Camps, Children's Message, VBS)
 - Cradle Cross Ministries
- Develop a Children's Ministry Team to oversee and offer:
 - Assistance with Children's Art Displays, Acolytes, and Children's Events.
 - Collaborative feedback on the ministry offerings.
- Collaborate with staff and leadership team on church-wide initiatives (e.g. Trunk or Treat, Children's Choir, Engage Events).
- Foster connections between the Day School and the Children's Ministry
 - Promoting Children's events, connecting with the Day School Director about shared events, and engaging with Day School families through special events (e.g. Mugs & Hugs, Day School pageants, etc.).
- Recruit, train, manage and recognize volunteers.
- Ensure compliance with the Child and Youth Protection Policy.
- Evaluate, select, order, and distribute curriculum and program materials.
- Create and maintain budget, financial and attendance records.
- Update database and registration information.
- Communicate (orally and in writing) all children's activities to the congregation, community, staff, and Leadership Team (i.e., email, social media, bulletin announcements, newsletter articles, etc.).
- Serve as the point of contact for all children's issues.
- Oversee and supervise the Nursery and Director of Childcare including recruiting and hiring childcare staff.
- Develop and direct children's educational activities in conjunction with church wide studies and other special educational events.
- Explore and implement new educational ideas/programs for children and/or their parents.
- Participate in staff meetings and staff development.
